At this point in time, the College does not have any outstanding recommendations to address. We are preparing for our First Year report due October 2011 to the NWCCU.</p>	<p>Currently, the campus is actively engaged in developing its Core Themes and core theme objectives and is preparing for the upcoming First Year Standard One report due in October 2011. We are also drafting responses to the other required standards as well as identifying required data for assessment of student learning and program review processes.</p> <p>As we work toward compliance to the new revised accreditation standards, the intranet Accreditation site is currently under constant revision. Actions taken by the college to address accreditation requirements are being posted on the site: http://intranet.shoreline.edu/accreditation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As in the last several years, during these difficult times, when the State system has significantly reduced colleges' budgets, Shoreline's evaluation and planning processes have kept the College stable. For 2009-2010, enrollments were up about 3.6 % annualized FTEs in spite of program reductions and personnel reductions for efficiency. Our improvement efforts are exemplified in our intense planning and college restructure. • Ongoing discussions about our five Core Themes, which are aligned with our Board of Trustees' updated Policy Governance Manual, has helped focus the college in its strategic planning and restructure. We are working on aligning all planning processes with our Core Themes. All units of the College are developing work plans in the context of our Core Themes.
